Students will create 3 panels each to take home (drying time does take 2 days, so they would have to be left at gallery57 in order to dry before being transported).

If time permits additional panels will be available for \$15 each.

Detailed class information will be provided, so you won't have to take notes.

This workshop will open your imagination when you witness the spectacular results you have created yourself.
